



WYC Covid Action

Dear Members;

The WYC Board of Governors met on Thursday 11-18-2021 to discuss the conduct of all social activity on the premises of our Club. It has been decided, by a vote of the Board, to immediately suspend all WYC social gatherings until further notice. This was not an easy decision and the discussion consumed a considerable amount of time. However, in the interest of health and safety for our membership, we feel this to be a necessary action.

By way of clarification the words above, "all WYC Social Gatherings" includes the following:

- · Member sponsored and Member Hosted Events
- WYC Social Events
- Friday night cocktails
- · Mahjong, book clubs, coffee get togethers, etc.

Why? The rate of COVID cases in the state of RI, and more importantly in Washington County, is showing a sharp increase in numbers as the weather gets colder and people move indoors. According to the RIDOH COVID website, the number of RI COVID cases in November increased from 141 per 100,000 to 222 per 100,000 and the positivity rate from testing jumped to 3.1% from 1.9%. Even more concerning, as of November 13, Rhode Island has had 12,810 "breakthrough" cases, including 83 breakthrough deaths. The new COVID variants are also exasperating this situation.

In addition, the input from a recent meeting of our medical members is as follow: "The Committee of Medical Professionals convened this evening to revisit the recommendation that was presented to the WYC Board of Governors back in September. Following the Committee's last meeting, steady improvement in the trend data began to show hope that some relief from the recommendation may be possible. Unfortunately, recent trend data now shows we are once again experiencing high community transmission and accelerating infection rates. This abrupt reversal in the trend data suggests we are not out of the woods yet. It remains clear however, that the risk for transmission of the virus and breakthrough infections is most severe whenever people are assembled in an enclosed, indoor environment.

In light of the reversal in the trend data the Committee stands by its recommendation that the club refrain from indoor social events and other indoor group gatherings where adequate social distancing cannot be achieved. Any large indoor assembly of people, where there is limited circulation of fresh air, presents a potential for transmission of the virus that is, in the opinion of the Committee, not worth the risk to our fellow club members."

The CDC guidelines remain consistent over time - indoor events should be avoided where social distancing and mask wearing is not practical. I think we all realize that at WYC social gatherings, amongst long term yachting friends eating, drinking and carrying on avid conversations, it is extremely difficult to maintain social distance and keep one's mask on.

Your Board is very saddened to have to make this decision. Our current plan going forward is to continuously monitor this situation with an eye towards returning to normalization as soon as possible. The journey to full recovery is taking longer than expected but with time and patience we remain confident it will soon be behind us.
